Dr. Chastre is licensed and board certified in cardiology with a subspecialty in critical care. He is a recognized expert in the performance of clinical outcomes research in the ICU setting, and his clinical research focus has been the understanding, diagnosis, and treatment of nosocomial infections and the improved care of mechanically ventilated patients. Dr. Chastre has published over 160 peer-reviewed papers, and authored or co-authored 14 book chapters.
