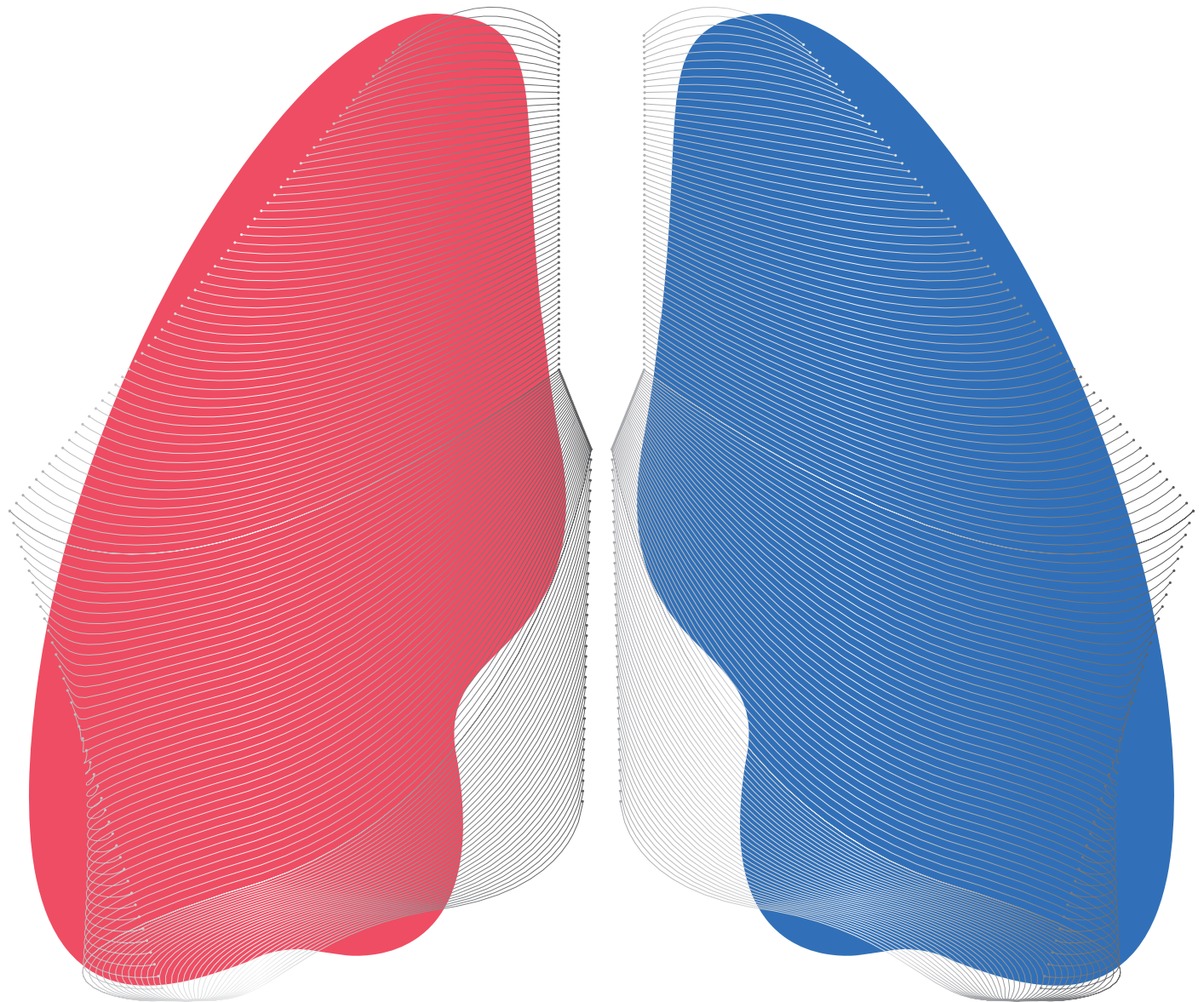

### The Korean Academy of Tuberculosis and Respiratory Diseases KATRD in Service of Humanity's Respiratory Health and Happiness

Started as an academic arm of the Korean National Tuberculosis Association (KNTA) in November 1953, KATRD has become a society that boasts a long history and tradition. Despite significant challenges in the wake of the Korean War, the society's first academic conference took place on November 7, 1953 thanks to its passion for research and its resolve for tuberculosis eradication. It was re-launched as the Korean Academy of Tuberculosis in 1961 and then renamed the Korean Academy of Tuberculosis and Respiratory Diseases in 1989.

KATRD's focus on academic advances through exchanges and harmony among its members has been the catalyst for both its continued growth over the last 65 years and its unrivaled position as a prime organization in the research and treatment of respiratory diseases like tuberculosis. It now has more than 1,620 members and has hosted 127 academic conferences. Its official journal, "Tuberculosis and Respiratory Diseases (TRD)," has been listed on PubMed, contributing to the international dissemination of its research findings, and it strives to elevate the journal to the SCI level.

With today's increased risks of respiratory diseases such as chronic obstructive pulmonary disease, lung cancer, bronchial asthma, and lung injury, KATRAD has designated Lung Day to promote the importance of pulmonary health and giving up smoking. This campaign to increase awareness among the general public has earned KATRD recognition as an exemplary academic society that fulfills its social responsibilities.

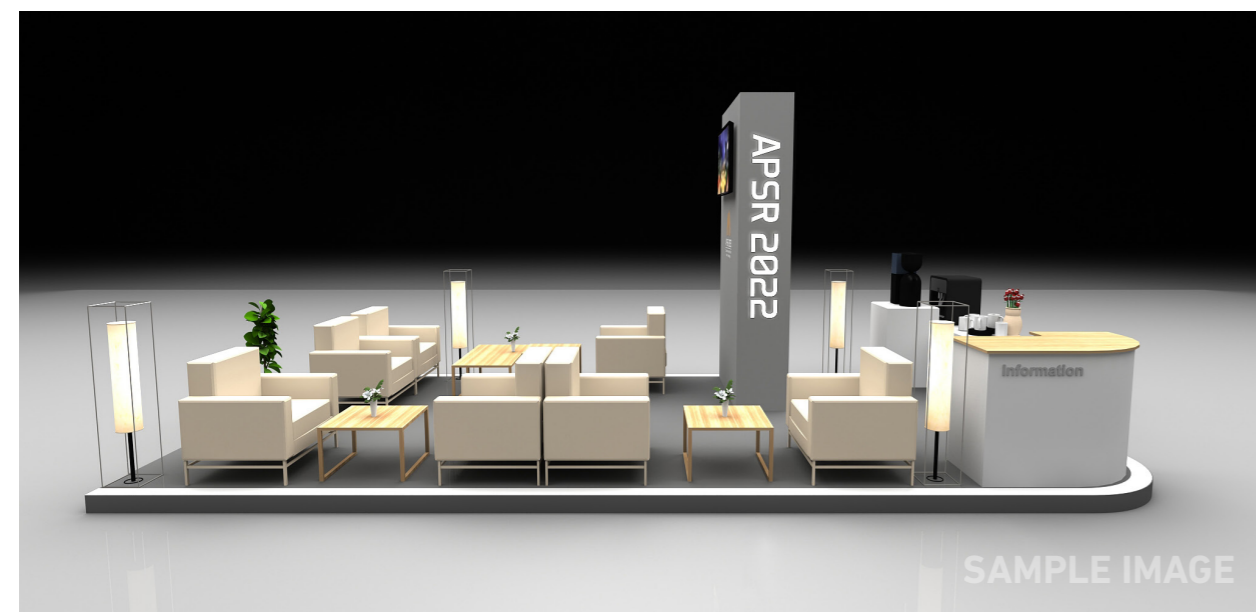

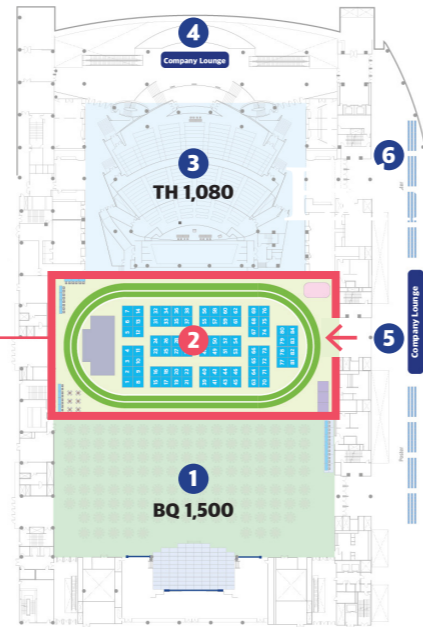
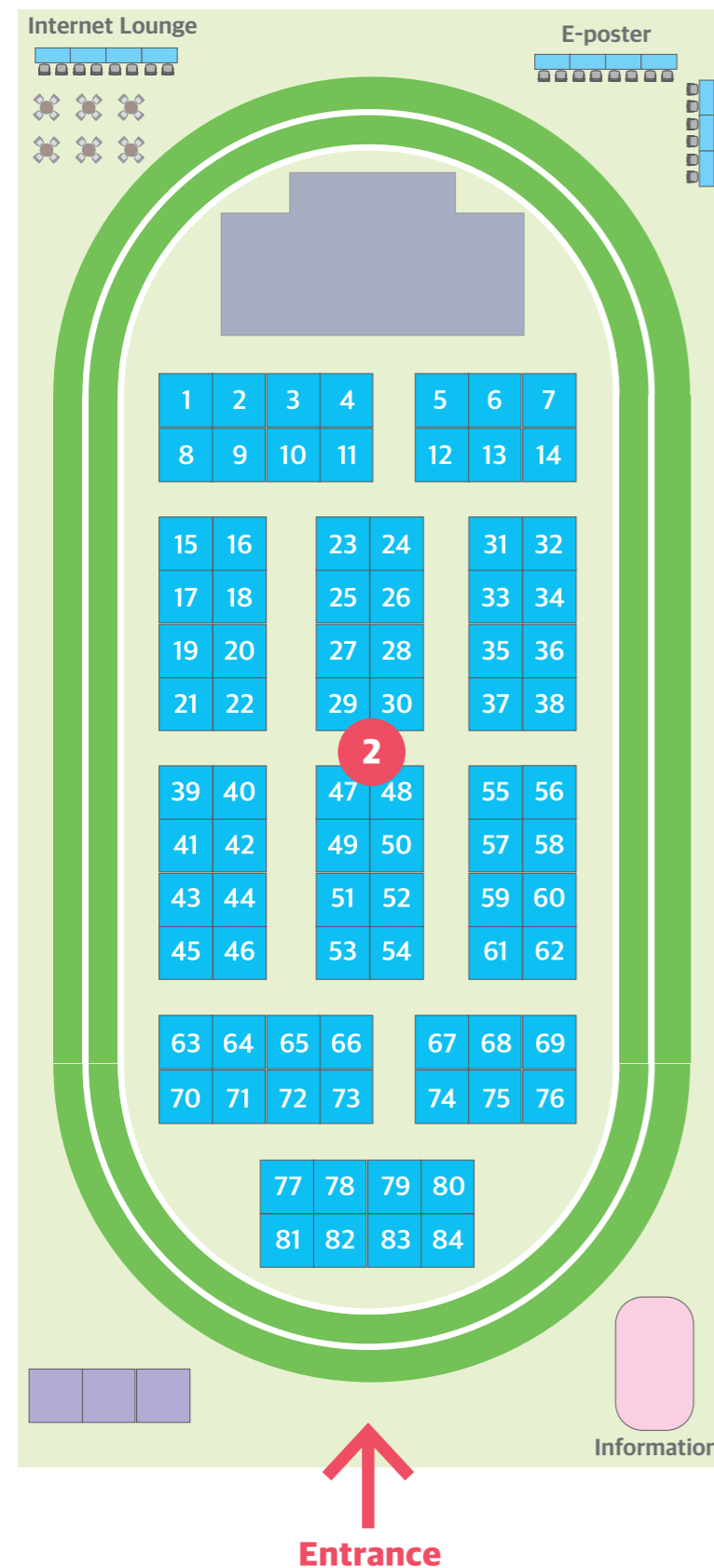
